

Directions to our Offices

Burt Langley's offices are located in downtown Asheville, just southwest of the intersection of Biltmore and Hilliard Avenues, near the Orange Peel music venue. We share a building with several other businesses around a small art gallery, Gallerie 149.

As you approach, look first for the large Gallerie 149 signs across the tops of our windows. You will see a smaller Burt Langley sign on the door. We are next door to the Storm Rhum Bar and Bistro; across the street you will see a row of quilt star murals. Please park on the street in the metered parking. If you note the zone and space number, we will be happy to cover your parking.

From Hendersonville:

Take I-26 W to the Downtown/Patton Avenue exit (4B). Continue along Patton into downtown; turn right on Lexington Avenue. Our office is on the right just past Hilliard Avenue.

From South Asheville:

Take Hendersonville Road north to downtown Asheville until it becomes Biltmore Avenue. Turn left on Hilliard (before the Orange Peel) and take the first left onto South Lexington. Our office is on the right.

From Weaverville and North Asheville:

Take I-26 E to Asheville; exit at Downtown/Patton Avenue. Continue along Patton into downtown; turn right on Lexington Avenue. Our office is on the right just past Hilliard Avenue.

From Highway 40 (Black Mountain/Swannanoa and East):

Take exit 53B onto Interstate 240W. Exit at Merrimon Avenue (5A) and turn left onto Merrimon. Stay straight onto Broadway/Biltmore Avenue. Take a right onto Hilliard Avenue (after the Orange Peel) and then the first left onto South Lexington. Our office is on the right.

From Highway 40 (Waynesville/Canton and West):

Take exit 46B onto Interstate 240E. Take the Downtown/Patton Avenue exit (4B). Continue along Patton into downtown; turn right on Lexington Avenue. Our office is on the right just past Hilliard Avenue.
